Support Installation: Install hangers, brackets, or support systems according to manufacturer specifications and NEC guidelines. Supports must be level and securely anchored.

Tray Assembly: Assemble trays and ladders, connecting sections with approved fittings. Use expansion splice plates if trays are exposed to temperature variations to accommodate thermal expansion.

Cable Routing: Install only tray-rated cables (Type TC, MC, or PLTC) and maintain proper separation between high-power and low-power cables to prevent electromagnetic interference. Fill limits should not exceed 40% for power cables and 50% for control cables.

Grounding and Bonding: Metallic trays must be grounded and bonded according to NEC Article 392 to serve as equipment grounding conductors if applicable.

Fire Safety: Where trays pass through walls or partitions, install firestop systems to prevent fire spread.
