- Breaker Ratings:** Match each MCB to the expected load of the circuit. For example, 6-16A for lighting, 16-20A for sockets, and 25-32A for high-power appliances.
- Future Expansion:** Leave space in the distribution box for additional breakers if needed.
- Compliance:** Follow local electrical codes (NEC, IEC) f...
