

Aggregation Switches and Aggregation Routers



AI Overview

Aggregation routers and aggregation switches both consolidate network traffic, but routers focus on edge routing and external connectivity, while switches aggregate internal traffic from access devices to the core.

Aggregation Router An aggregation router (also called an Aggregated Services Router or ASR) is primarily used at the network edge to combine multiple traffic streams from internal and external networks, including the internet and cloud services, into a single high-performance routing platform . Key functions include:

- Traffic consolidation:** Combines multiple WAN or LAN links to increase throughput and efficiency.
- Edge routing:** Manages traffic between internal networks and external networks or cloud services.
- Security and reliability:** Provides encryption, firewalling, and high availability for enterprise or service provider networks.
- Support for SD-WAN:** Enables software-defined WAN management by aggregating multiple WAN connections and applying policies across the network .

Aggregation routers are essential for large enterprises and service providers to handle high-bandwidth applications, remote work, and multicloud environments efficiently.

Aggregation Switch An aggregation switch sits between access switches and core switches in a network hierarchy, consolidating traffic from multiple access points, wireless devices, or edge switches before forwarding it to the core . Key features include:

- Traffic aggregation:** Bundles multiple physical links into a single logical connection using protocols like LACP or MC-LAG, enhancing bandwidth and redundancy .
- Layer 2/3 operations:** Can operate at Layer 2 for switching or Layer 3 for routing, depending on network design.
- Load balancing and failover:** Distributes traffic evenly across links and provides redundancy in case of link failure.
- Network performance optimization:** Offloads processing from core switches, improves scalab...
