Daisy Chain Topology: Switches are connected sequentially, which can be simpler for small networks but may introduce latency and bandwidth sharing issues. Fiber optic cabling mitigates these limitations by supporting high-speed data transfer.

Connection Methods

Direct Fiber Connection: Insert SFP modules into each switch and connect them with duplex fiber cables. Ensure the correct type of fiber and module is used for the distance and bandwidth requirements.

Direct Attach Cables (DACs): For short distances, DACs with pre-terminated SFP modules provide a cost-effective and low-latency solution.
