Cables typically enter through the sides or bottom, and the box may include built-in terminals for joining wires. Some models, like the AP75 junction box, feature multiple cable entries on the sides and bottom, allowing flexible wiring options. Junction boxes can be surface-mounted, recessed, or embedded in walls, ceilings, or concrete, depending on the installation requirements.
