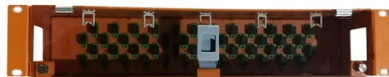


Botswana needs electricity



Overview

Botswana's electricity supply remains structurally constrained as the country still does not have a reserve margin, requiring continued power imports alongside new generation capacity and demand-side interventions to maintain grid stability. Electricity can be generated in two main ways: by harnessing the heat from burning fuels or nuclear reactions in the form of steam (thermal power) or by capturing the energy of natural forces such as the sun, wind or moving water. Electricity production tends to closely match demand, which in turn. Botswana's electricity generation saw a notable increase in the third quarter of 2024, rising by 11.1 percent to 988,303 megawatt-hours (MWH) compared to 889,535 MWH during the same period in 2023.
