- Securing the Cable:** Wire Clamps or Hooks: For permanent installations, use specialized wire clamps or hooks designed for butterfly cables. These clamps provide UV protection, corrosion resistance, and adjustable tension to hold the cable securely without damaging it.
- Routing Considerations:** When running the cable along walls, corners, or conduits, ensure it lies flat and is supported along its length. Avoid sharp edges or abrasive surfaces that could damage the outer sheath.
