

Cable Management of Huawei Core Switches



AI Overview

Proper cable management for Huawei core switches involves installing cable management frames securely, following ESD precautions, and organizing cables to maintain airflow and accessibility. Key Steps for Cable Management Installation

1. Prepare the Equipment and Workspace

4. Maintain Accessibility and Airflow
Ensure cables do not block ventilation areas to prevent overheating. Label cables for easy identification during maintenance or troubleshooting. Keep sufficient slack for future upgrades or reconfigurations.
5. Series-Specific Notes
S12700 Series: Follow the above steps; multiple frames can be installed in the same manner for larger chassis.
S7700 and S9700 Series: Installation procedures are similar, with attention to ESD precautions and secure frame attachment.

Best Practices
Regularly inspect cable management frames and cables for wear or loose connections. Use color-coded or labeled cables to simplify network management. Avoid stacking cables tightly; maintain a clean layout to facilitate airflow and reduce maintenance time. For stacked switches, ensure cabl...
