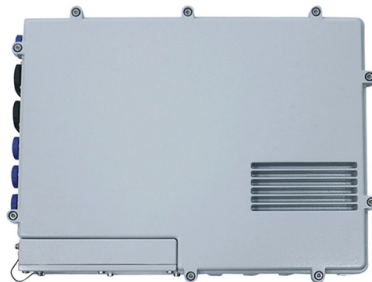


Cable Tray Fabrication Instructions

Cable tray fabrication involves selecting appropriate materials, assembling sections with fittings, and installing them according to safety and design standards to securely support electrical cables.

Material Selection Choose the cable tray material based on the environment and load requirements. Assemble Units: Connect tray sections using bolts, clamps, or welding as specified. Maintain proper alignment and spacing to support the cable load evenly.

Install Supports: Use hangers, brackets, or channel supports to secure the tray to walls, ceilings, or structures. Spacing of supports depends on tray type and load, typically every 1.5–3 meters for ladder trays.

Check Structural Integrity: Ensure the assembled tray system is rigid, level, and capable of supporting the intended cable weight, including allowances for short-circuit forces.

Installation Guidelines

Maintain minimum bend radius for cables at tray exits to prevent damage.

Use rung spacing of 150–230 mm for ladder trays to support instrumentation and control cables.

Avoid using trays as walkways or ladders to prevent personal injury and system damage.

Install covers if required for protection against dust, heat, or electromagnetic interference.

Bundle and balance cables at the center of the tray to prevent uneven loading.
