

Cable Tray and Cable Drain Installation

Planning and Preparation Before installation, review approved shop drawings and site layouts to determine tray routes, lengths, and locations. Ensure civil and MEP clearances are available and mark horizontal and vertical runs, avoiding clashes with other services. Store trays and ladders horizontally on flat surfaces with timber supports at 1-meter intervals, protecting them from moisture and sunlight ().

- Ladder trays:** Ideal for power cables, allow airflow, and provide easy cable entry ().
- Ventilated troughs:** Support smaller control and instrumentation cables, prevent sagging ().
- Solid-bottom trays:** Used where heat buildup is minimal or aesthetics are important ().
- Composite trays (FRP):** Non-conductive, corrosion-resistant, suitable for chemical or high-moisture environments ().

Select materials considering corrosion resistance and mechanical strength. Aluminum, stainless steel, and galvanized steel are common choices depending on environmental conditions ().

Installation Steps

- Route Marking:** Use a laser level to trace straight lines for tray placement ().
- Support Installation:** Mount trays using wall brackets, cantilever arms, or ceiling hangers. Support spacing typically ranges from 1.5 to 3 meters, depending on tray type and load ().
- Tray Assembly:** Connect sections with splice plates, ensuring edges align smoothly to prevent cable damage. Allow slight movement for thermal expansion ().
- Cable Pulling:** Organize cables by voltage and function using cable ties or straps. Maintain minimum bend radius and avoid overfilling trays ().
- Grounding and Bonding:** Metal trays must be electrically bonded and grounded using proper jumpers to maintain continuity and comply with safety c...
