Supports should be spaced according to tray type and load, typically 1.5 to 3 meters apart. Grounding and Bonding Metal trays require proper grounding and bonding to maintain electrical safety. Use bonding jumpers across tray sections to ensure continuity and prevent electrical hazards. Cable earthing should be done at instruments or panels as required.
