Installation: Elbows are designed to integrate seamlessly with straight sections using couplers, clips, or fasteners, maintaining structural integrity and alignment.

By selecting the correct width, side height, and bend radius, a 200mm elbow cable tray ensures proper cable management, heat dissipation, and compliance with electrical installation standards.

When vertically stacking ladder trays always maintain adequate clearance above each tray run to allow for the installation of the cable and start with the narrowest (lightest) tray on top and work downwards
