Electro-galvanized trays have a thin, uniform zinc layer applied via electrolysis, offering moderate corrosion resistance. They are cost-effective and suitable for indoor or controlled environments but less durable in marine or industrial conditions.

Appearance and quality requirements: The galvanized coating should be continuous, uniform, and smooth. Minor dull areas or passivation films are acceptable, but defects like bare spots, blisters, or excessive zinc dross are not permitted.

Powder Coating Powder coating provides a barrier protection by isolating steel from corrosive environments. It is highly resistant to acids, alkalis, and chlorinated compounds, and offers unlimited color options, smooth surfaces, and zero VOC emissions. Powder coating is preferred in data centers, commercial buildings, food processing, and chemically aggressive industrial environments. Unlike galvanization, it does not provide sacrificial protection, so any damage to the coating may expose the steel to corrosion.
