

Cable tray column installation method

Mounting Methods Cable tray columns can be supported using:

- Trapeze hangers:** Ideal for ceiling suspensions, providing stability and easy access for maintenance.
- Cantilever wall brackets:** Mounted directly to walls for vertical or horizontal runs along walls.
- Floor-mounted columns:** Used for vertical risers or where ceiling support is not feasible, ensuring the column is plumb and anchored securely to the floor.

Ensure all supports are level, aligned, and securely fastened. Use appropriate clamps, bolts, and brackets to prevent movement or vibration.

Alignment and Safety Align columns vertically and horizontally to maintain a straight tray path. Maintain minimum bend radii for cables at tray entry and exit points to prevent damage. Ensure proper bonding and grounding of the tray system according to NEC Article 392 or local electrical codes. Avoid using trays as walkways or for supporting personnel, as they are designed solely for cable support.
