

Can a meter be mounted on a distribution box

It is generally not appropriate to mount a meter inside a distribution box unless the enclosure is specifically designed and approved for both metering and distribution equipment.

Regulatory and Utility Requirements Utilities and Distribution Network Operators (DNOs) require that meter enclosures remain accessible for readings, maintenance, and future upgrades. Only equipment directly associated with the supply and metering—such as the meter, main isolating device, and communications hub—is permitted inside the meter box . Installing additional devices, like switches or consumer units, inside the meter enclosure can lead to rejection by the utility and may require removal at the customer's expense .

Clearance and Safety Meter boxes must maintain sufficient clearance for safe operation. Front and side access must be unobstructed to allow technicians to work safely, even in adverse conditions . Overcrowding a meter enclosure with distribution equipment can violate these clearance requirements and create hazards.

Practical Installation Advice If a property requires both a meter and a distribution board, the recommended approach is to install them in separate enclosures or in a combined enclosure specifically designed and approved for dual use. Some guidance allows mounting a meter on a fireproofed wooden or metal backboard if the wall is thin, but this must still comply with DNO access and safety...
