

Can a wireless panel be connected to a fiber optic cable

- Configure the network:** Access the wireless panel's admin interface to configure SSID, security settings, and other network parameters.

Practical Considerations

- Compatibility:** Ensure your wireless panel or router supports the speeds provided by the fiber connection. Fiber-ready or gigabit-capable devices are recommended.
- Distance and cabling:** Fiber can transmit over long distances without signal loss, but Ethernet connections from the ONT to the wireless panel are limited to about 100 meters unless using PoE extenders or additional switches.
