

Can an LED light splitter change the brightness



Overview

An RGB LED splitter connects multiple LED strips to a single 3-pin ARGB header without losing brightness or control. So if your LED bulbs consume a maximum of 10w, that lighting fixture is built to theoretically withstand 6 of them. If it's a modern fixture that has a much lower wattage, say, "up to 15w", that limits the amount of bulbs (load) that you can use in that fixture.
