

Can cable trays be used when passing cables through walls

All gaps around cables or metal trunking should be tightly sealed, and cover plates should be used to close the opening. Alternatives to Cable Trays in Walls Instead of trays, cables passing through walls are typically routed through: Conduits or raceways: Metal or nonmetallic conduits provide mechanical protection and maintain code compliance. Fire-rated sleeves: These allow cables to pass through walls while maintaining fire-resistance ratings. Direct penetration with firestopping: For small bundles, cables can pass directly through a wall opening if properly sealed with firestop materials.
