Pulling Techniques: Always pull fiber optic cables by the strength members (usually aramid yarn/Kevlar), not the jacket, unless the manufacturer allows it . Use swivel pulling eyes to prevent twisting. Avoid exceeding the cable's maximum pulling tension and maintain the minimum bend radius. Securing Cables: Use cable ties or Velcro straps...
