

Can fiber optic cables be routed at right angles



Overview

This is true to a degree, a fibre optic cable can't be manipulated like a copper cable and where possible should be laid in a straight line. It is measured from the inside of the bend, not the outer curve. Fiber optic cables transmit data through light propagation within a glass core. Bending Fiber Optic 90 Degrees

We bend optical fibre 90 degrees (or loop it for a full 360!) all the time. It isn't a question of angle of bend, it's one of RATE OF BEND. The smaller the radius the more the attenuation.
