For single-phase domestic installations, the main supply connects to a double-pole MCB, then to an RCCB, and finally to output MCBs for individual loads. Each load is connected to the output terminals of the appropriate MCB, with the neutral and earth wires properly linked to the neutral and earth busbars. Directly connecting a plug to the DB would bypass these protective devices, which could lead to overload, short circuits, or electric shock hazards.

Safety and Code Compliance Only appliances designed for hardwiring should be connected directly to a DB. Standard plug-in devices should remain connected via outlets to ensure circuit protection and compliance with electrical codes. If hardwiring is necessary, it must be done using a dedicated circuit, proper junction boxes, and correct wire sizing according to the load. All connections should be performed by a licensed electrician to meet safety standards and local regulations.
