Smart Grid and Electrification Strategy Canada is pursuing mass electrification to reduce emissions and improve energy efficiency. Strengthening electricity systems involves modernizing transmission and distribution networks, integrating renewable energy, and ensuring reliability and affordability. Smart grid technologies enable real-time monitoring, demand response, and efficient energy distribution, forming the backbone of the Energy Internet.

Broadband and Digital Infrastructure High-speed internet is essential for the Energy Internet, enabling smart meters, grid automation, and remote energy management. By early 2025, 93.5% of Canadian households had access to high-speed internet, with fiber and upgraded cable networks providing gigabit speeds to urban and suburban areas. Satellite services like Starlink and Xplore extend connectivity to remote regions, ensuring that smart grid technologies can operate nationwide. The Universal Broadband Fund aims to reach 98% of households by 2026 and 100% by 2030.
