Viewing Optical Module Information

Diagnostic information: `display transceiver diagnosis interface` This command provides digital diagnostic monitoring (DMM) data, including transmit/receive power, voltage, current, and temperature.

Interface status check: `display interface` This displays the interface rate, module type, link status (UP/DOWN), and traffic statistics, which are essential for troubleshooting link issues.

Quick overview of all interfaces: `display interface brief` Use this to identify interface types and numbers if you are unsure where the optical module is installed.

Key Points for Optical Module Verification

- Ensure the link status is UP; a DOWN status indicates a problem with the module or connection.
- Check the optical power levels to confirm they are within the recommended range. Low or high power may indicate fiber issues or module faults.
- Verify the module is Huawei-certified, as non-certified modules may cause installation issues, abnormal data bus behavior, or damage to the interface.
- Monitor temperature, voltage, and current to ensure the module operates within safe limits.

Troubleshooting Tips

- If the module is not recognized, try reseating it or checking for compatibility issues.
- Use the verbose option in the `display transceiver` command to get detailed information for troubleshooting.
- Compare the diagnostic readings with the expected specifications for the module type to identify potential faults.
