

China Unicom relocation of optical cables



Overview

China Unicom Group, one of China's major telecommunications operators, has revealed plans for the construction of a nearly 3,000-kilometer-long submarine optical fiber cable, which will span from Hong Kong to Sihanoukville in southern Cambodia. Recently, a centralized procurement project of a provincial China Unicom company was announced to be terminated. It accelerates the construction of network infrastructure and actively plans computing power , enhanced the breadth and depth of mobile network coverage and user perception. Although the project was issued at the end of 2024, the bid will be opened in.
