

Circuit connected to distribution box

A circuit is connected to a distribution box through branch circuit breakers, which receive power from the main supply via busbars, with neutral and earth connections ensuring safety and proper operation. Components of a Distribution Box

A distribution box, also called a DB box or panelboard, is the central hub for distributing electrical power to multiple circuits in a building. Key components include:

- Main Breaker or Main Switch:** Acts as the primary disconnect for the entire system, controlling the incoming power supply to all circuits.
- Busbars:** Solid metal bars (usually copper) that distribute power from the main breaker to individual branch breakers.
- Branch Circuit Breakers (MCBs):** Protect individual circuits from overloads and short circuits. Single-pole breakers disconnect only the live wire, while double-pole breakers disconnect both live and neutral for higher safety.
- Neutral Bar:** Collects return conductors from all circuits, maintaining balanced operation.
- Earth/Ground Bar:** Provides a safe path for fault currents to dissipate into the ground, protecting equipment and personnel.
- RCCB or RCD:** Monitors current leakage and disconnects power if a fault is detected, enhancing safety in domestic installations.

Connecting a Circuit

Power Input: The incoming supply (phase and neutral) is connected to the main breaker.

Distribution via Busbars: The main breaker feeds the busbars, which carry power to all branch breakers.

Branch Circuit Connection: Each circuit is connected to a branch breaker. The live wire goes through the breaker, the neutral wire connects to the neutral bar, and the earth wire connects to the ground bar.

Load Connection: From the branch breaker, wires run to the specific load (lights, sockets, or appliances).

Single-Phase vs. Three-Phase Systems

Single-Phase: Common in residential setups, with one live wire and one neutral wire. Branch breakers are connected to a single busbar.

Three-Phase: Used in commercial or industrial installations, with three live wires (L1, L2, L3). Load balancing across phases is important to maintain system stability.
