Rack Dimensions and Load Capacity: Verify height (common 42U/45U/48U), depth, width, and static load rating (aim for $\geq 1500\text{kg}$). **Construction and Materials:** Look for cold-rolled steel (SPCC) frames and tempered glass doors for durability and safety. **Maximum Aisle Length:** When equipment cabinets form a continuous row, the aisle length should not exceed 16 meters. Most IT environments default to 42U, 19-inch width, and 1000–1200 mm depth unless space constraints or special equipment dictate. Most all Sun servers are designed for rackmounting in cabinets or racks that comply with the EIA 310D standard.
