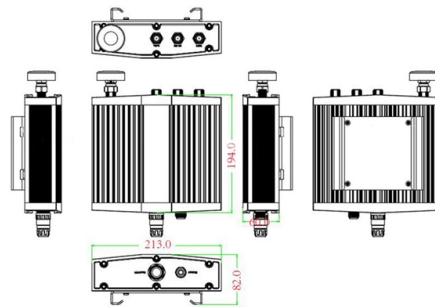

For most European countries and regions following IEC 60446:

- Protective Earth (PE): Green/Yellow striped, exclusively used for grounding
- Neutral (N): Light Blue, also used for intrinsically safe conductors
- Single AC Phase (L1): Brown
- Three-Phase AC (L1, L2, L3): Brown, Black, Grey (UK extension allows grey for line conductors), PEN (combined protective earth + neutral in TN-C systems): Light Blue with Green/Yellow markings at ends

NEC (National Electrical Code, US) Standard Colors

For the United States and regions following NEC:

- Protective Ground (PG): Green, Green/Yellow, or Bare Copper
- Neutral: White or Gray
- Live/Hot Wires: Any color except green, yellow, white, or gray; commonly black, red, or blue for single-phase and three-phase systems

DC Wiring Colors

- Positive (+): Red
- Negative (–): Black
- Ground/Earth: Green or Green/Yellow

Key Considerations

- Consistency:** Always follow local regulations and labeling practices, especially in older installations where legacy colors may differ
- Labeling:** When mixing old and new wiring, use labels to avoid confusion
- Safety:** Correct color identification prevents miswiring, reduces shock risk, and simplifies maintenance
- Industrial Applications:** Large conductors may be black with colored tape at ends to indicate phase or polarity
