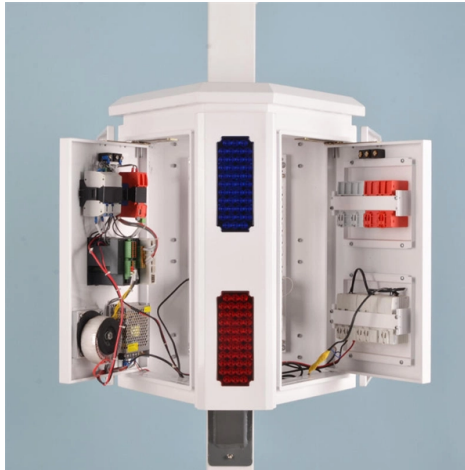


Comparison of Fiber Optic Cable Products

Cable Construction Types

Loose Tube: Fibers are housed in a gel-filled tube, ideal for outdoor and long-distance installations, resistant to moisture and temperature changes.

Tight Buffered: Fibers are coated individually, easier for indoor installations and patch cords, providing flexibility and protection.

Armored Cables: Include a stainless steel spiral or metal layer for rugged environments, protecting against physical damage.

Tactical Cables: Polyurethane jackets for rapid deployment, withstand heavy flexing and vehicle traffic, used in military or broadcast applications.

Ribbon Fiber: Fibers arranged in flat ribbons for mass fusion splicing, reducing labor in high-count cables.

Micro/Blown Fiber: Ultra-slim cables for air-blown deployment in micro-ducts, allowing scalable network expansion without trenching.

Application Environments

Indoor/LSZH: Low-smoke zero-halogen jackets for safe indoor use.

Outdoor/ADSS: All-dielectric self-supporting cables for power line installations, resistant to ice, wind, and electromagnetic interference.

FTTH Bow-Type Drop Cable: G.657.A2 bend-insensitive fiber for last-mile installations, can be stapled or bent around corners without signal loss.

OPGW: Optical ground wire for high-voltage towers, combining lightning protection with fiber backbone.
