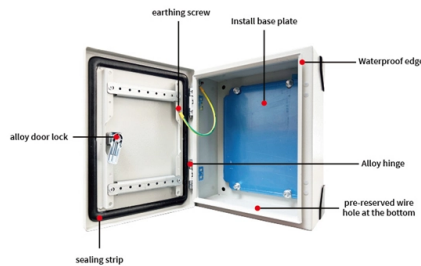

Accessibility and Code Compliance: According to the National Electrical Code (NEC), all junction boxes must be accessible without removing any part of the building structure or finish. Cut the Wall Opening: Measure the box dimensions and cut a precise hole in the drywall or wall surface. Keep the box aligned while cutting.

Mount the Box: Secure the box to a stud or wall frame using screws or nails. For recessed boxes, ensure the front edge is flush with the finished wall surface.

Run Conduits and Wires: Pull wires through the conduits into the box, maintaining gentle curves to avoid strain.

Cover and Conceal: Install a junction box cover or a decorative panel. Covers can be painted or matched to the wall finish. For aesthetic concealment, a false wall or drywall patch can be used, ensuring the box remains accessible.

Test and Finish: Verify the circuit is de-energized before connecting wires. After wiring, secure connections with wire nuts, attach the cover plate, and finish the wall with plaster or paint as needed.
