

Concealed wiring process for electrical distribution boxes

Color Coding: Use grey PVC pipes for data cables and black PVC pipes for electrical wiring. Apply PVC solvent for secure connections.

Switch and Junction Boxes: Install back boxes for switches and outlets, ensuring they are not clustered in high-traffic areas and are aligned with the electrical drawings.

Distribution Box Wiring Inside the distribution box, organize circuit breakers, busbars, terminal blocks, and wires neatly. Each circuit should have its own protection device (breaker or fuse). Ensure proper grounding, correct wire gauge, and insulation. Label all circuits clearly for future maintenance and troubleshooting.

Safety and Compliance Avoid placing conduits near lintel beams, columns, or roof beams to maintain structural integrity. Follow local electrical codes (NEC, IEC, or regional standards) and use UL/CE-certified components. Perform visual inspections...
