

Conduit from distribution box to electrical equipment



Overview

Rigid Metal Conduit (RMC) and Intermediate Metal Conduit (IMC) use fittings with external threads that screw directly into the connector or box opening. For non-metallic options, such as PVC conduit, a male adapter transitions the conduit to the electrical box. NEC Article 314 establishes requirements for the installation and use of electrical boxes, conduit bodies, fittings, and handhole enclosures. Conduit functions as a durable enclosure, shielding the electrical conductors from physical damage, moisture, and corrosive elements. - The doors of the distribution room and static compensator enclosures should be reliably connected to the protective conductor using copper core flexible wires. Conduits are the means in which power cables run from the ground to the electrical equipment and appliances.
