

Configuration of Dual-Fiber Optic Switch

Step 2: Prepare Duplex Fiber Cabling Use duplex LC-style fiber cables or pre-terminated cables with LC connectors. When connecting two switches, reverse the connections between the SFP ports: the transmit (TX) of switch A connects to the receive (RX) of switch B, and vice versa. This ensures proper signal flow.

Step 3: Connect the Switches Insert the SFP modules into the fiber ports of both switches. Connect the duplex fiber cables according to the reversed TX/RX pattern. If using dual fiber connections for redundancy or increased bandwidth, you can connect two separate SFP ports on each switch.

Step 4: Configure Switch Ports Set the SFP ports to fiber mode if the switch supports combo ports (shared copper/fiber ports). Enable link aggregation (LACP) if you want to combine the two fiber links into a single logical interface for higher throughput and redundancy. Ensure duplex mode and speed match on both ends. Activate the VLANs on the fiber interfaces if necessary, typically VLAN1 for default connectivity.

Step 5: Verify Connectivity Check the link status using commands like `show interface status` or `show ip interface brief` on Cisco switches. The SFP port LEDs should be lit, indicating a successful connection. If the link is down, verify: Fiber type and SFP compatibility, Correct TX/RX orientation, Matching port speed and duplex, Proper VLAN configuration.
