

Configuration of OLT and Core Switch Interconnection



AI Overview

An OLT connects to a core switch via uplink ports using VLANs and management interfaces to ensure traffic segregation, bandwidth control, and network stability.

OLT Overview An Optical Line Terminal (OLT) is the central device in a Passive Optical Network (PON) that aggregates traffic from multiple Optical Network Units (ONUs) or Terminals (ONTs) and interfaces with the core network. It manages downstream and upstream traffic, allocates bandwidth, and ensures time synchronization with ONUs using protocols like MPCP in EPON networks. The OLT also handles VLAN tagging for data, voice, and IPTV services.

Core Switch Interconnection Uplink Configuration: Connect the OLT uplink port to the core switch using a high-speed Ethernet interface (1G/10G depending on traffic requirements). Configure the uplink as a trunk port on the core switch to carry multiple VLANs corresponding to different services (data, voice, IPTV).

VLAN Planning: Define VLANs on both the OLT and core switch to segregate traffic. Assign VLAN IDs for each service type and ensure consistent tagging across the OLT and core switch. Example: VLAN 10 for data, VLAN 20 for voice, VLAN 30 for IPTV.

Management Access: Configure the OLT management interface for in-band or out-of-band access.

Out-of-band: Connect the OLT management port to a dedicated management VLAN on the core switch.

In-band: Use the uplink port with a dedicated IP subnet for remote Telnet/SSH access. Ensure proper IP addressing and routing between the OLT and network management system.

Traffic and Bandwidth Control: Use the OLT to allocate bandwidth per ONU/ONT using GATE and REPORT messages in EPON or equivalent mechanisms in GPON. Configure QoS policies on the core switch to prioritize traffic types and prevent congestion.
