

Connecting the cable finder to the switch

Adjust the volume knob for clarity, especially in noisy environments, and use earphones if provided. The receiver will help differentiate the target cable from other nearby cables.
- 5. Trace and Confirm** Follow the cable to its endpoint, whether at a wall jack, patch panel, or device. The receiver will produce a stronger signal when near the correct cable. Mark the cable or bundle as you go to avoid confusion.
- 6. Test Cable Integrity (Optional)** Many cable finders can also test for open circuits, shorts, miswires, or reversed connections. Use the emitter to check the physical connection status and verify proper wiring.
- 7. Additional Tips** If the cable is carrying PoE, check if your tool supports live tracing; otherwise, disconnect the cable. Use the LED flashlight on the receiver for dark spaces. Avoid stripping the cable unless using alligator clips for bare wire testing. Always follow the manufacturer's instructions for your specific cable finder model. By following these steps, you can...
