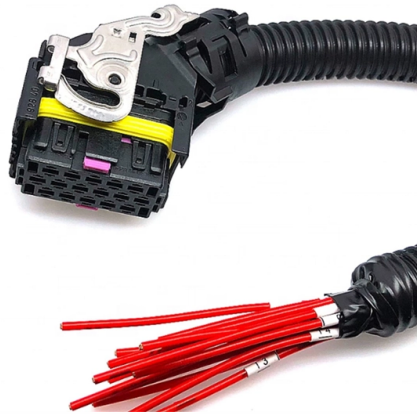


Connection method for cable TV fiber distribution boxes

Secure the fiber trunk with cable ties or clips, but avoid over-tightening, and route individual branch fibers neatly to their respective ports.

Step 4: Connect to the ONT The fiber output from the distribution box is connected to an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) inside the home. The ONT converts optical signals into electrical signals for TV, internet, and phone services. For TV, the ONT typically provides an Ethernet output that connects to a router or directly to a fiber-compatible set-top box. The set-top box then decodes the signal and outputs it to the television via HDMI.
