

Connection of lc-type optical fiber and optical module

Secure the Connector: Depending on the connector type, use the latch mechanism to lock the fiber in place. For duplex connections, ensure transmit and receive fibers are correctly paired.

Attach the Boot: Slide the connector boot over the ferrule to protect the fiber and provide strain relief.

Remove Dust Caps: Take off the protective dust caps from both the LC connector and the optical module port.

Align and Insert: Orient the connector according to the keying mechanism and insert it into the module port until you feel a slight click, indicating proper engagement.
