- Disconnect Wiring:** Remove all wiring, conduits, and junctions from the distribution box back to the panel, taking care not to damage adjacent systems.
- Dismantle the Box:** Detach the distribution box from its mounting, ensuring that all components are safely handled. Salvage or dispose of materials according to project specifications.
- Label Breakers:** Mark breakers as "spare" or "removed" to maintain clarity for future electrical work.

- Site Supervisor:** Ensures daily adherence to procedures and secure work areas.
