

# Copper wire at cable tray connection

In such cases, it is recommended to use an insulated copper conductor and remove the insulation only at bonding points, using tin- or zinc-plated connectors to attach to the tray, raceways, or equipment enclosures. Connection Methods Copper grounding wires can be connected using: Grounding clamps or brackets at tray joints to maintain electrical continuity. Bolts or welds to secure the wire at each connection point, preventing breaks and ensuring low-resistance paths. Full-length continuous conductors along the tray for consistent grounding, especially in long runs. Code Considerations All metallic cable trays must be grounded according to NEC Article 250.96, regardless of whether the tray itself is used as the EGC. The minimum cross-sectional area of the tray or wire must meet NEC Table 392.60(A) requirements for the circuit's protective device rating. Aluminum trays should not be used as EGCs for circuits with ground-fault protection above 2000 amperes, and steel trays are limited to 600 amperes. Best Practices Use insulated copper wire in aluminum trays to prevent corrosion. Bond the wire at every tray section or at alternate sections for mechanical and electrical reliability. Ensure low grounding resistance, ideally 4 ohms or less, to maintain effective fault protection. Avoid placi...
