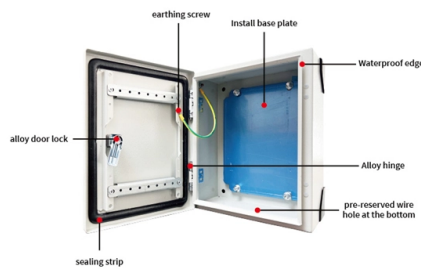


Core Switch of Monitoring Network

Redundancy: Many core switches include dual power supplies, hot-swappable modules, and link aggregation to maintain continuous operation even during component failures. Advanced Management: Core switches provide a centralized point of control for traffic management, security policies, and monitoring, often supporting SNMP, CLI/Web GUI, and automation integrations. Security and QoS: They can implement quality of service (QoS) to prioritize critical monitoring data and include advanced security features to protect sensitive network traffic. Architecture The internal architecture of a core switch is optimized for speed and reliability: Switching Fabric: The core component responsible for forwarding packets between ports. Routing Engine: Determines the optimal path for data packets. Port Modules: Provide physical connections for network devices.
