Rack Depth Depth is critical for fitting modern servers, storage arrays, and GPU systems. Typical depth options include:

- 600–800 mm:** Suitable for network switches, patch panels, and shallow equipment.
- 1000–1200 mm:** Recommended for deep chassis servers, storage arrays, and high-performance computing equipment.

Adjustable mounting rails allow flexibility for varying equipment lengths and rear cable clearance.
