

Distance from fiber optic cable to router

The fiber optic cable should ideally run within 3 meters of the ISP's entry point to the ONT, and the ONT can then connect to the router via an Ethernet cable up to 100 meters. Ethernet cables can theoretically run up to 100 meters without significant signal degradation, allowing flexibility in router placement within the home. For higher speeds or future-proofing, Cat6a or Cat7 cables are recommended, especially if the router supports gigabit or multi-gigabit connections.

Cable Routing: Avoid sharp bends and maintain the minimum bend radius. Use gentle curves around corners and door frames.
