Ensure trays are level, aligned, and securely fastened. Use connectors and fittings to join sections, and employ cable tray rollers for long runs to prevent kinks during cable installation.

Cable Laying and Organization Lay cables neatly within the trays, maintaining proper separation by voltage and function. Use cable ties or straps to secure cables, leaving slack for expansion or future adjustments. Observe minimum bend radii to prevent cable damage and ensure airflow in ventilated trays.
