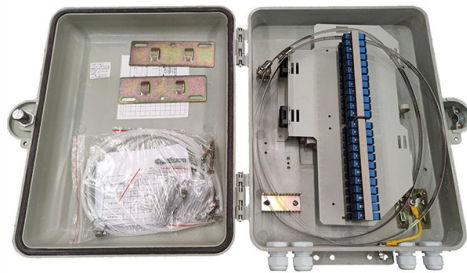


Distribution Box Ground Installation Method

- 3. Connect to the Box:** Attach the ground wire to a metal part of the box, such as a threaded stud or a marked grounding terminal. For stainless steel boxes, use serrated washers and conductive grease to maintain low contact resistance and prevent corrosion.
- 4. Connect to Mounting Plate and Ground Rod:** Connect a second wire from the mounting plate to the central grounding point or a ground rod buried in the earth. Ensure the contact area is sufficient for a secure connection. For outdoor or industrial boxes, braided copper tape can be used between the door panel and box body to maintain continuity.
- 5. Test Ground Resistance:** Use a voltmeter or ground resistance tester to measure the resistance between the box and the grounding point. The resistance should be less than 0.1 Ohm for industrial systems or below 25 Ohms for general safety standards. If resistance is too high, adjust the ground rod location or add additional rods.
- 6. Bonding and Continuity:** Ensure all metallic components, including enclosures, raceways, and equipment, are bonded into a con...
