It integrates sensors, processors, communication networks, and switches to collect, analyze, and optimize data from substations, feeders, and consumer endpoints, enabling utilities to automate key processes such as fault detection, feeder switching, voltage control, and outage management. Communication Networks: Reliable information and communication networks are essential for transmitting data between sensors, controllers, and central management systems, ensuring real-time monitoring and control.

Monitoring and Control Systems: DA systems include software and hardware for supervising, measuring, and controlling electrical loads, enabling predictive maintenance and rapid response to faults.
