Splice plates should be placed on the outside of the cable tray, unless otherwise specified by the manufacturer, with the bolt heads on the inside of the cable tray (see Figure 3-37).

INSTALLATION GUIDE

Make sure all surfaces of the pulling devices that come in contact with the cable and ladder tray are covered by a protective covering of plastic or tape to prevent surface scoring.
