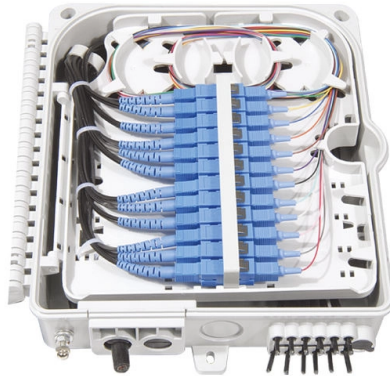


Do relay protection systems need to be calibrated annually
