Steel-armored cables (GYTS and GYTA53) must be grounded at both ends to prevent lightning-induced current. Ungrounded armor acts as an antenna and will destroy sensitive SFP modules. Sharp bends inside handholes are the #1 cause of field-repaired links. These cables include metallic components that can carry electrical currents, presenting potential hazards such as electrical shock or fire.
