These cables can carry high-bandwidth data over fiber while simultaneously delivering electrical power through the copper wires, similar to Power over Ethernet (PoE) systems. This approach is commonly used for devices like IP cameras, VoIP phones, and remote network units where running separate power lines is impractical.
