- Single-Pole MCBs:** Protect individual circuits such as lighting, outlets, and small appliances. Ratings commonly range from 10–20 A depending on the load.
- Double-Pole MCBs:** Used for high-power appliances like air conditioners, water heaters, or kitchen ovens, rated 20–32 A.
- Neutral and Earth Bus Bars:** Central points for connecting neutral and grounding wires.
