Drill through the center of the bracket channel and the tray if using cover clamps or splice connectors. For dividers or end plates, align holes with the pre-existing rung or tray holes to simplify installation. When using sleeve inserts, square holes allow for 2 or 4 bolt securing solutions, depending on the application.

Fastening: Use dome-headed bolts, nuts, and washers with finishes suitable for the tray material (galvanized or stainless steel) to prevent corrosion. Recommended torque values are typically 10–35 Nm, depending on bolt size and tray type. In areas with vibration, a small bead of elastic adhesive on the bolt thread can reduce loosening.

Spacing Between Holes: For dividers, holes are often spaced 900 mm apart and secured at 4 locations along the divider. Ensure that all drilled holes maintain a minimum 40 mm clearance between the tray and the supporting s...
